TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

1. Arrival to the IBIS hotel

On arrival you can take Bolt taxi (or normal taxi) to reach the hotel. Price is up to 10 eur (10 min drive to Ibis hotel from the airport).

2. Purchasing a bus ticket

As we have **3 external visits** (Wise on Wednesday, Education and Youth Board of Estonia (HARNO) on Tuesday and E-Estonia Briefing Center on Wednesday) plus daily visits to Taltech we recommend to purchase a 5-day transport ticket for local transport (11 eur). The ticket can be purchased in the small shop called R-KIOSK. The closest R-KIOSK shops are:

Lauteri, **10145 Tallinn** (a shop near the Ibis hotel)

Or

Vabaduse väljak 2, 10146 Tallinn (a shop at the main square)

3. Arrival to Taltech university


The address of the venue is **Akadeemia tee 3**, 12616 Tallinn.

You may take Bolt taxi or **bus 67**. The travel duration is 37 minutes. You make take the bus starting at 8-52 and you arrive at the 09-29.



The bus stops at the stop on the big park side (please see the picture – bus stop EHITAJATE TEE), so you need to pass it and come to the building of the School of Business and Governance (Akadeemia tee 3), 5 min:



The entrance to the SBG (School of Business and Governance) building:

4. Arrival to Wise office (Tuesday 29 August). Address is Veerenni 24

What is Wise

Wise (formerly TransferWise) is a UK-based foreign exchange financial technology company founded by Estonian businessmen Kristo Käärmann and Taavet Hinrikus in January 2011. Wise specializes in cross-border payment transfer. Becoming a startup unicorn in 2011, the Estonian-founded FinTech Wise is now valued at \$5B+. By now there are five unicorns born in Estonia in total, Skype, Playtech, Bolt and Pipedrive being the other four.

We have booked an introductory meeting with WISE starting at 11-00 Tuesday. We suggest a **walking trip** from the Ibis hotel to the Wise office at Veerenni 24 (as there is no direct bus available). The walking distance is 1,2 km.
